- we will focus on red words and high frequency words, and how we can tackle these in our writing. - in maths we will look at simple addition by adding two groups together. We will work on some higher order addition strategies, linking our knowledge of the wholeness of a number to help us e.g. 6+2=8 because I know that 8 can be made of a 6 and a 2. We will then move onto adding by 'counting on' from the largest number first.

Please continue to support reading at home with your child, completing their green reading log. Please complete the Read, Write, Inc. letter formation sheet.

Red words/high frequency words – Please practise reading these 6 words with your child, as many times as you can. Try cutting them up, paying snap or even sticking them around the house! Children have to see these words at least 100 times before they securely retain it in their long term memory. Your child may or may not know these words, but don't worry, it's all about practising them.
