Headteacher's Notes

Dear parents and carers,

I would like to start this week's newsletter with a huge THANK YOU to our wonderful children and families for making such a positive start to our new year. Despite the challenge of the intense heat our children have been super stars and have shown their determination to settle into routines and make an excellent first impression. It has been refreshing to catch up with the children about their summer break and to hear about how much they are enjoying being back in school with friends and getting on with learning. This year, we welcome Mr Cox as our Year 2 class teacher with Miss Boyd as Y2's teaching assistant and Miss Fazakerley as Year 3's new teacher. They have all settled in quickly and we wish them every success at Robins Lane Community Primary School.
