Dear parents and carers,

I think lots of our children (and the staff) will need an early night tonight after completing the first full week of teaching. I have been impressed by the children's attitudes to learning, their conduct around school and in lessons.

This week, we have launched our new assembly programme. The children come together daily as a school community – each day has a different focus. On Monday, I opened a series of assemblies about 'Extraordinary People' by discussing Sir David Attenborough. The children were fascinated and his message "The future of humanity, and, indeed, all life on Earth, now depends on us" made them think deeply about how, inspired by these wise words, we can all make a positive difference in our world. We are delighted to announce that our school has now received the Silver Award for the Primary Geography Quality Mark. We have been upgraded from our previous achievement of Bronze which we achieved in 2020. Well done to all of the children and the staff at our wonderful school for making our Geography curriculum and learning a huge success!
