# Headteacher's Notes

Dear parents and carers,

What a busy week we have had – our second full week of teaching and learning is complete, and our children have settled admirably into their new classes and routines.

On Tuesday, I continued my series of assemblies focusing on 'Extraordinary People' by discussing the former 'First Lady' of the United States -Michelle Obama. The children really impressed me with their knowledge of global leaders and were fascinated by Michelle Obama's story and her message "There is no magic to achievement. It's really about hard work, choices and persistence." This simple yet powerful message made the children think about how this links to our WINGS values and inspired them to invest in lessons and learning. Next week, we will be reflecting on the life of Frida Kahlo so you might want to discuss this in advance!

This week, we have welcomed families into school for our 'Meet the Teacher' sessions. On the subject of staying safe – thank you to our wonderfully mature Year 6 children who have accepted that we can't let them play football on the playground before school as we can't safely supervise it. I was impressed by their attitude and understanding.

At the time of writing this newsletter, the rain was pouring down – I do hope it clears soon and the sun puts in an appearance allowing you to get outside and enjoy the fresh air.
