# Headteacher's Notes

Dear parents and carers,

Another busy week in school which has finished on a high note with sunshine and a beautiful blue sky – let's hope it stays around for the weekend.

On Wednesday we saw the continuation of our 'Beacon Project' run by Merseyside Fire Service. This week, the group travelled into Liverpool to visit the Merseyside Water Rescue Station which is based at the Albert Dock. They learnt about how to stay safe around water and rivers. The children then went on the famous ferry 'cross the Mersey' which for some of them was their first time on a boat. The afternoon was spent being taught First Aid techniques and how to react in an emergency situation. Lots of important learning and experiences packed into a day!

Our Beacon group were not the only children venturing out of school this week. On Wednesday, Year 5 and Year 3 joined forces and travelled to Tatton Park near Knutsford in Cheshire.

Our Year 5 linked their visit to their historical enquiry and explored the world of the Anglo Saxons and Vikings in 10th Century AD in an exciting, hands-on workshop. They were able to understand what life was like for the Anglo Saxons and Vikings. They learnt all about the importance of deer, how communities would all work together to make items like bread and finally, how to protect themselves against any invaders. Thank you to Mr Lownsbrough and Year 5 staff for organising this fantastic trip and to our parent volunteers who helped out.

In addition to Year 5, our curious Y3 historians also had an exciting and informative day at Tatton Park. The trip was planned to support Year 3's learning around the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages. The children engaged in lots of fun, hands-on activities, such as getting to handle and learn about different types of Stone Age tools, investigating how people managed to build things and the materials they used to do this. They even learned how to light a fire with flint! Thank you to Miss Fazakerley for organising this experience and to the Year 3 staff and parent volunteers who helped out. This week, in EYFS, we held our final open morning event. Nursery and Reception children inspired us with their warm-hearted attitudes as we invited new families into our classrooms. The visiting children and parents loved exploring the learning environments, getting stuck in with lots of the activities on offer and making new friends.
