Dear parents and carers,

Following our letter last night, we are working quickly to establish our new routines and procedures. Whilst we await updated guidance and further information, we wanted you to know the following information today:

School places

If you have proven you are a key worker and require a place, you must confirm this by 3pm on Thursday 7th January. To secure a place, your child must attend school 5 days per week, Monday to Friday. We are not able to offer flexible/part-time arrangements like in last year's lockdown. This is in-line with current guidance and consistent with many St Helens schools.

Please note that school places are subject to availability. If you are eligible and do not take up a place initially, we may not be able to offer a place later on should you change your mind.

Accessing remote learning

This week, you can find home-learning activity packs on the school website (underneath the home-learning tab). If you need a paper copy, please let us know. Last term, we sent you two blank exercise books to record your child's work. Let us know if you need a replacement.

On Friday, we will be uploading a guidance video on our full remote learning offer for next week onwards. It will include details of our live teacher meetings and pre-recorded help videos. We will send you the link once it is available.

Breakfast and after-school club provision

Both clubs will close on Friday 8th January until further notice. To those planning to use these clubs this week, we urge you to make alternative arrangements as soon as you can. If you made an upcoming booking, we will refund these early next week.

School day timings

For the rest of this week, school day timings will remain unchanged. However, to facilitate remote learning, start and end times may change from Monday 11th January. We will confirm this later in the week.

Lunches/Free School Meals

If you are entitled to a free school meal, and need one providing this week, please let our office staff know. You will then be able to collect the lunch between 12pm-12:30pm
