Dear parents and carers,

Full school reopening – updated guidance

Further to my letter on Tuesday, I can confirm that most of the government reopening guidance remains similar to that produced in September. Therefore, most day-to-day systems in place in September will indeed return and remain unchanged. I will send a reminder of these systems next week.

However, you should anticipate the following minor changes to our procedures:

Attendance – From Monday 8th March, school attendance is once again mandatory for all pupils.

Staff wearing masks – As of yesterday, our staff (unless exempt) now wear face masks when in corridors, communal areas and at the door during pick-up/drop-off times.

Educational visits – Until further notice, educational visits are not recommended. We have already cancelled our Reception and Year 5 trips. This is under constant review, so our summer term trips/residentials remain active for the time being.

Pupils travelling from abroad – Where pupils have travelled into the UK from abroad, they must first quarantine at a managed quarantine hotel for 10 days. (We are not aware of this affecting any of our pupils.)

Childcare arrangements – Where parents/carers use multiple or out of school providers, this should be kept one if possible.
