Headteacher's Notes

Dear parents and carers,

This week, in assembly, we continued the theme of inspirational women in sport – our focus was the incredible story of boxer, Nicola Adams. Nicola excelled in the male dominated boxing world from a very early age and she was determined to fulfil her dream of being an Olympic boxing champion before it was even a women's category! Achieving this dream was not easy physically or financially – her mum had many jobs and often worked until midnight to pay the bills. All of the sacrifice was worthwhile when, in 2012, Nicola became the first woman in boxing history to win a gold medal – a feat that she repeated in Rio in 2016. She said of herself, 'People don't really see male or female. Now when they see me box, they just see a good boxer.' What a truly inspirational athlete.

Sport has been high on the agenda this week as Robins Lane completed a very successful Sports Day on Monday. It seems that whenever we announce our Sports Day date the weather gods align to make it the hottest day of the year! The children, staff and families coped admirably with the extreme conditions and we were pleased to be able to continue. From our Nursery children, through to Reception, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 – our WINGS were visible and in action across events.
